## Fountain Grove II East Political Sign Guideline Clarifications

(Proposed 3/19/2024; sent for comment 4/18/24; dated approved by Committee: 7/16/24)

The FGII East CCRs currently state at Article 3.5 <u>Restricted Uses</u>, section (vi) (b):

No sign of any kind shall be displayed on any Lot so as to be visible from any public right-of-way or any other Lot except the following...

(b) Any sign of a political nature, provided the sign is placed inside a window; ...

Notwithstanding this section of the CCRs, pursuant to Civil Code section 4710, the ARC is creating the following political sign guideline/rule:

Temporary political signs must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Signs must be placed on Owner's Lot;
- 2. No more than five (5) signs total on a Lot;
- 3. No more than one (1) sign per candidate or measure;
- 4. Signs can be no larger than 18" x 24";
- 5. Signs can be placed in windows or can be installed by stakes in front yard of Lot.
- 6. Signs cannot be placed any sooner than sixty (60) days prior to the scheduled election and must be removed within seven (7) days after the election;
- 7. Signs shall not be posted or placed in any way that poses a hazard or sight visibility problem;
- 8. Should not be posted on trees, utility poles or fencing from edge of the public right-of-way;
- 9. All signs must be maintained in good condition.
